

the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles as set forth in N.J.R.S. 39:4-138, any other New Jersey statute or as hereinafter provided.

11-3.2 Parking Prohibited During State of Emergency.

a. Whenever snow has fallen and the accumulation is such that it covers the street or highway, no vehicle shall be parked on any of the roadways or portions thereof located within the Township of Piscataway. The above parking prohibitions shall remain in effect after the snow has ceased until the roadways have been plowed sufficiently and to the extent that parking will not interfere with the normal flow of traffic. **[Amended 1-6-04; Ord. No. 04-01]**

b. Upon the declaration of an emergency, there shall be no parking upon streets or sections of streets where temporary emergency no-parking signs are displayed. The mayor or the mayor's designee is authorized to declare an emergency and to direct the posting of emergency no-parking signs when weather conditions, accidents, fires or public celebrations dictate or require the avoidance of hazards or other conditions which interfere with the free flow of traffic. Notification that emergency no-parking signs are being or will be posted shall be given to the operator or owner of any vehicle which has been parked prior to the posting of the signs. **[Amended 11-29-05 by Ord. c. Any unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation of this section shall be deemed a nuisance and a menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic, and any peace officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner shall pay the reasonable costs of removal and storage which may result from such removal before regaining possession of the vehicle.

d. The effectiveness of this subsection is contingent upon signs being erected as required by law.

11-3.3 Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets. No person shall park a vehicle at any time upon any of the streets or parts thereof described in Schedule II, attached to and made a part of this chapter.

11-3.4 Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours on Certain Days. No person shall park a vehicle on the days and between the hours specified in Schedule III upon any of the streets or parts of streets
