Reduced fares, at anytime, are available on NJ Transit buses, trains and light rail, to seniors age 62 and over and people with disabilities. Personal assistants ride for free. Seniors must present a valid ID or NJ Transit Reduced Fare ID card. People with disabilities may show NJ Reduced Fare ID card or Medicare card. Applications for Reduced Fare ID cards are available online at www.njtransit.com or your local Office of Aging and Disabled Services.
