Submission Guidelines

- Exhibit dates: November 1, 2016 – November 30, 2016.
- Submit photo of service member on **Saturday, October 29, 10 A.M. - 2 P.M.**, at the Piscataway Municipal Building, 455 Hoes Lane, Piscataway.
- Minimum size: 5 x 7 Maximum size: 11 x 14
- All photos must be framed and have a **wire hanger** for hanging. Saw tooth, hook or ring hangers cannot be accepted, our hanging system only accommodates wire picture hangers.
- Complete all sections of attached form and submit with photo. (Please print clearly) Entry forms will also be available at the time of submission.
- Piscataway residents may submit photos of loved ones regardless of their residency.
- Photo of individual must be in U.S. Military uniform.
- Pick Up: All photos must be picked up at close of exhibit Wednesday, November 30, 2016 between 6 P.M. and 9 P.M. Piscataway Municipal Building.
