U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Reviews Cleanup at Chemsol, Inc. Corporation Superfund Site

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is currently conducting the fourth five-year review of the implemented actions at the Chemsol (Operable Unit -2) Superfund site, located in Piscataway, Middlesex County, New Jersey.

The purpose of this five-year review is to ensure that the remedy is functioning as intended and continues to be protective of public health and the environment. To conduct the five-year review, EPA will review site operation, maintenance, and monitoring information, as well as the status of the land-use controls.

What is an EPA Five-Year Review?

The purpose of this five year review is to ensure that implemented remedies at Superfund sites function as intended and continue to be protective of human health and the environment. These regular reviews, which are required by federal law when contaminants remain at a site, include:

- Inspection of the site and cleanup technologies;
- Review of monitoring data, operating data, and maintenance records, and
- Determination if any new regulatory requirements have been established since EPA's original cleanup decision was finalized.

When will EPA's Five-Year Review Report be available?

It is anticipated that the five-year review report for the Chemsol, Inc. Superfund site will be available at the website noted below by June 2015.
