GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Please note that all programs are subject to change by the Department of Recreation.
- Participants in Piscataway Recreation sponsored events do so at their own risk and accept responsibility for all their actions and injuries incurred by their participation. Prior to submitting a claim to the Township, injured parties must first use their own medical/ accident insurance as their primary coverage. The insurance offered by Piscataway Township is supplemental and secondary only. If a claim qualifies for consideration, the Township insurance is limited to a maximum payout of no more than \$5,000.00 per accident.
- It is now mandatory in New Jersey for all school aged youth that wear corrective eyewear while participating in recreation programs and activities to wear "Protective Eyewear" that meets American Society for Testing and Material Standards (ASTM) for frames, and American National Standards Institute (ANSI) for lenses.
- For use of Township facilities, parks, ball fields and courts, a certificate of insurance and a Defense and Hold Harmless agreement are required, as well as a permit issued by the Department of Recreation.


