

## Piscataway Senior Center Membership Criteria

- The Township of Piscataway is proud to provide services to our senior residents through the Department on Aging. The Center hours of operation are Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., Monday & Thursday 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. and Saturday 8:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.
- A nutrition program is offered Monday through Friday for breakfast and lunch and home delivery of lunch to the frail and homebound seniors of our community.
- Transportation is available to *enrolled members only* by calling (732) 743-2218 twenty-four hours in advance or by signing up at the Senior Center.
- Personal Care Assistants may ride the bus with their senior clients who are members of the Senior Center, after filling out registration information.
- Temporary members or guests may not use the Senior Center Transportation.

To become a member of the Piscataway Senior Center, participate in building programs, or to utilize the transportation system the following criteria must be met:

### Age 60 or older

Applicants must provide and verify their age by one of the following documents: Birth certificate; passport; driver's license, or other official photo I.D. with their date of birth listed.

### Piscataway Resident

A permanent resident is defined as a person living in Piscataway for 6 or more months. One of the following documents with the applicant's name and address on it will be used to verify residency: A current driver's license, current tax bill, current utility bill, and current bank statement, imprinted checks with name and address, or business mail received within the last 30 days.

### Spouses of Senior Center Members

Any center member who has a spouse between 50-60 years old is entitled to have their spouse participate in the center's scheduled activities as a member. Proof of age and marriage is required.
